Dilynodd Amy-Marie y cwrs 6 wythnos cychwynnol a oedd, yn ei dro, wedi helpu i leihau'r gorbryder a'r straen yr oedd hi'n eu teimlo. Ar ben hynny, daeth yn amlwg yn gyflym bod ganddi ddawn am grefft siwgr, ac aeth ei sgiliau, ei gwybodaeth a'i hyder o nerth i nerth.

Roedd ei phrofiad dysgu mor gadarnhaol fel y penderfynodd hi ddilyn gyrfa mewn addurno cacennau ar ôl y cwrs, gan sefydlu ei busnes ei hun o'r enw 'Cake Queens'.

Amy-Marie Rees' story demonstrates how through commitment to learning and determination to succeed, she was able to overcome barriers, change the course of her life and become an inspiration to others.

Amy-Marie had previously been in employment, but following the birth of her child, Amy-Marie's circumstances changed, and she found herself isolated and suffering from stress, anxiety and depression. As a result, she attended counselling sessions where it was suggested that becoming involved in an activity might help her as well as opening up opportunities to socialise with other people.

This was a daunting prospect for Amy-Marie as she explained: "The thought of walking into a room full of people I didn't know was terrifying." Despite this, she realised her need to find something to do, and when she spotted an advert for a sugar craft course, she applied.

Amy-Marie attended the initial 6-week course which in turn helped to reduce levels of anxiety and stress she was experiencing. And it quickly became apparent that she had a 'flair' for sugar craft, and her skills, knowledge and confidence went from strength to strength.

Her positive learning experience was such that following the course, Amy-Marie then decided to make a career out of cake decorating, setting up her own business called 'Cake Queens'. Amy-Marie commented, "It has inspired me to get out there and get back working for a living."

We wish Amy-Marie every success with her business, future career and further learning; she is an inspiration and a role model to others and truly deserving of our Margaret Jones Award.

Funding Your Learning

You may be eligible to apply for funding to support your learning. However the amount you can get may depend on your personal circumstances, your age, joint family income and the level of course that you intend to study.

Financial Contingency Fund

Depending on your personal circumstances you may be eligible to apply for support through our Financial Contingency Fund (FCF). This fund supports assistance with disability costs, books, equipment, registered childcare fees, transport, stationery, associated fees and educational visits. Application forms are available from area offices or your Curriculum Delivery Officer.

Student Finance Wales

If you intend to study one of our higher level courses or you are thinking of applying to a college or university you may be eligible to apply for funding from Student Finance Wales. Learner stories - Mohammed, Fouad, Ramez and Hassan



A group originating from war-torn Syria have resettled with their own and other families in Ystradgynlais.

Their story demonstrates the commitment they have made to their learning, in order to overcome significant barriers to community integration and employment.

In Syria our learners had jobs, careers and businesses, but on arriving in Wales had to start all over again. They spoke little or no English and were recovering from various traumas wrought by their experiences in Syria.

They attended ESOL classes provided by Addysg Oedolion Cymru | Adult Learning Wales which helped to build their confidence and language skills.

The support that the learners have received from the local community has been widespread due in no small part to their positive interaction with locals. They have also used their learning to help offer support to others who are in a similar situation and to ensure the integration of their children in local schools.

ESOL tutor Amel Cherif observed, "The learners desire to further their education and achieve employment has been commendable. They are a shining example of how courage and self-belief, with the good will and help of a supportive community can bring such devastated families back to a life that is positive and hopeful."

Our congratulations to all on winning the Siân Thompson award and we wish the group and their families every success for their futures.
